From the pool deck you will find direct and private access onto the beach in just a few steps... unparalleled beachfront bliss on this unspoilt coastline of Southern Mozambique!

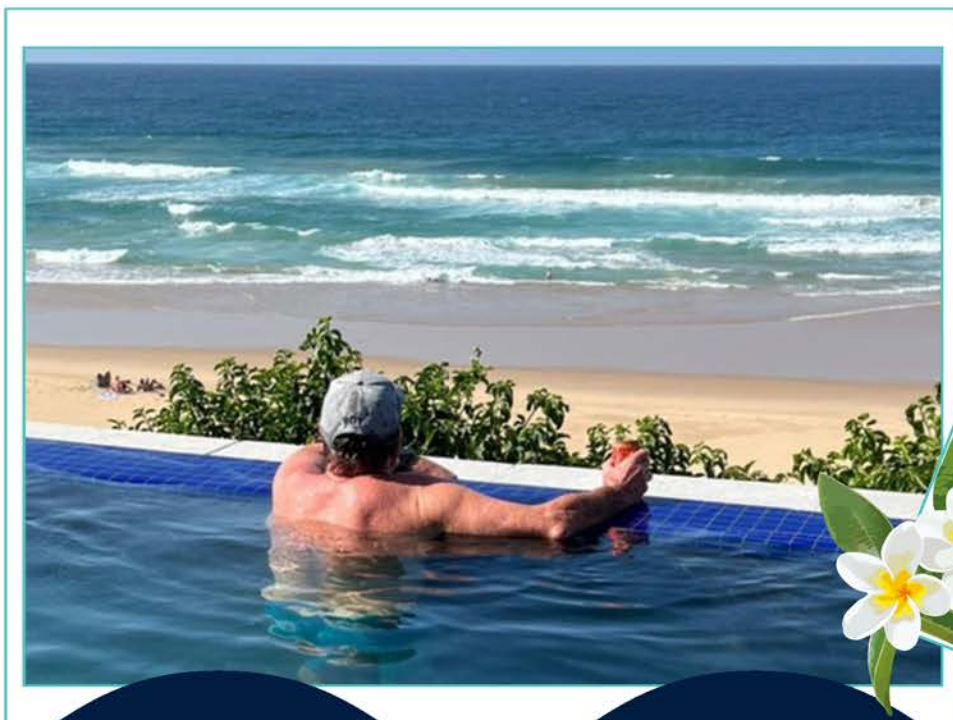
Our friendly and attentive staff, Gerry, Rosa, Helena and Afonso, will take great care of you! They are on duty from 7h30 to 16h30 everyday.



THE POOL DECK

On arrival at the Villa, you will park your cars and walk down a few stairs into the house. Here you will find the open plan living area which consists of a lounge, kitchen, scullery and guest bathroom. The living area leads out on the wooden deck where you will find the large, rim-flow infinity swimming pool overlooking the beautiful Indian Ocean. There are sun loungers on the deck for those who are wanting to spend some time relaxing at the pool. Beach / pool towels are provided.

There is a comfortable fire pit area with both a cooking area and a central fire area behind the lounge. Firewood and charcoal can be purchased locally. There is a gas braai for those that prefer cooking on gas rather than coals.



THE BEDROOMS



This private and modern villa sleeps 14 guests in 5 tastefully decorated bedrooms.

2 of the bedrooms are family rooms comprising of a queen bed and a bunk bed.

3 of the bedrooms are honeymoon suites consisting of a queen bed.

Each room has an Aircon, ceiling fan and an ensuite bathroom.

All of the rooms open onto their own private deck, where sunrises can be enjoyed whilst soaking up the magnificent ocean and beach view.

Linen, bath towels and amenities are provided.

THE LOUNGE & KITCHEN

The main living area comprises of a lounge and a spacious fully-equipped kitchen with fridges, freezers, microwave, kettle, toaster, air fryer, stove, ice machine etc. All crockery and cutlery is provided, as well as drinking water provided by a reverse osmosis system on the centre island.

The lounge area has comfortable seating, a dining table and a smart TV offering Netflix and YouTube.

Complimentary WiFi is provided at Blue Waves. Due to the remoteness of the area, we cannot guarantee that WiFi will always be functioning seamlessly. We recommend that you also purchase a Mozambique Vodacom SIM card and data in case there are periods of outage.

The living area opens up onto a deck with a large infinity pool overlooking the beach. The deck has an outdoor seating area and a dining table.

ABOUT PONTA MAMOLI

Ponta Mamoli is situated on the south east coast of Mozambique, nestled in a pristine natural coastline, approximately 100kms south of Maputo and 25kms north of Kosi Bay Border.

A number of rare and varied ecosystems can be found in the area, from unspoilt expanses of beach, dune forests, fresh water coastal lakes and floodplains characterised by expanses of bulrushes and papyrus.

Ponta Mamoli is well known for its pristine natural coastline with a subtropical climate. Here you will find magnificent expanses of beaches and unspoilt offshore reefs which offer excellent scuba diving and snorkelling.

It is no surprise that Ponta Mamoli is considered to be one of the top beaches in the whole of Mozambique!



ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA

THINGS TO DO CLOSEBY

There is a great variety of things to do and see in the area besides the usual beach activities, such as swimming, snorkelling, tanning and leisurely beach walks.

Those that prefer more action-packed holidays will not be disappointed!

- Turtle Nesting Season

From October through to March and you have a very good chance of seeing the turtles laying eggs on the beach at night... sometimes right in front of the villa! Please respect and be mindful of keeping your distance and minimising any form of disturbance so as to allow these incredible sea creatures to follow nature's course. Lights chase the turtles back into the sea so use of any form of light during turtle viewing is strictly forbidden.



ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA

- Dolphins and Whales

Dolphins are often seen surfing the waves in front of Blue Waves almost all year round. Whales can be seen breaching from the decks at Blue Waves from July to October. Dolphin viewing boat rides and swimming with dolphins can be arranged from Ponta do Ouro or Ponta Malongane.

- Massages at the Villa

Marcella, our local qualified masseuse, offers incredible massages for R300 an hour. Please speak to Gerry if you would like to book a massage and he will arrange with Marcella (a minimum of 2 persons is required). She will come to the villa and do the massage at Blue Waves, either in the privacy of your own room or on your private deck.



ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA

- Town Hopping

Ponta Malongane is a fun 25-minute drive away on the dune roads. This little village is famous for its vibey bars and restaurants and is a great place to go for meals and a fun night out with music, dancing and great company!

Small bars and restaurants will be found from here all the way down to Ponta do Ouro, a 45-minute drive away from Blue Waves. Don't hesitate to stop in and have a drink to experience the local hospitality!

- Scuba Diving

There are scuba diving centres in both Ponta do Ouro and Ponta Malongane. They supply all your diving gear and some of the dive centres also offer dive courses, so even if you are not a qualified diver you can still manage to experience and underwater adventure!

- Snorkelling

Frederico's Bay, a famous snorkelling spot, is only a few hundred meters away from Blue Waves. At low tide, Frederico's becomes an amazing snorkelling spot right from the beach, or to just wallow in the calm waters, so make sure that you pack your snorkelling gear for your stay at Blue Waves!

- Deep Sea Fishing

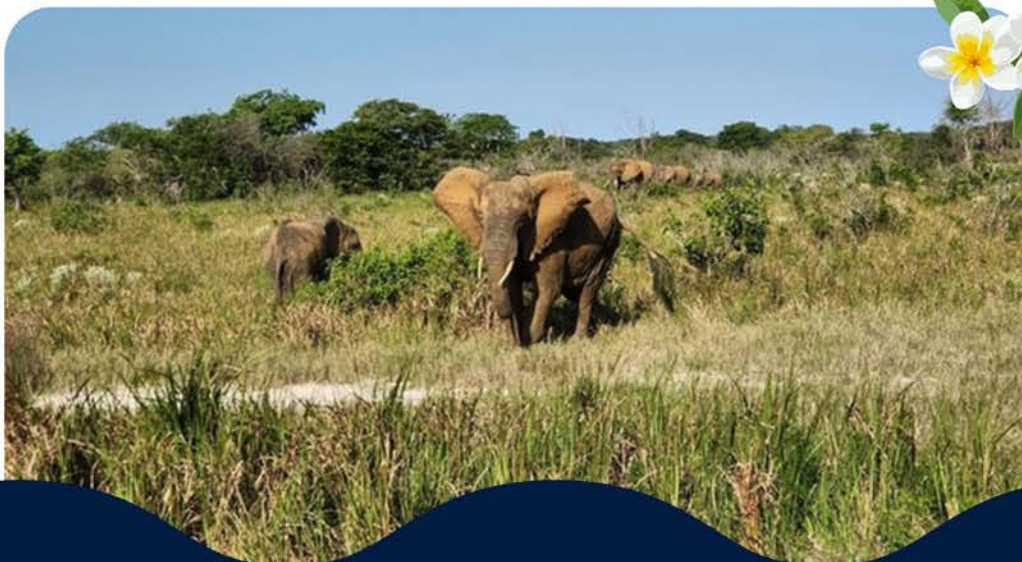
Deep Sea Fishing is very good along this stretch of coast. There are great fishing charter companies in Ponta do Ouro who will take you on a full day deep sea fishing trip. Keep your catch of the day for a spectacular, fresh seafood dinner back at the Villa!

- Beach Horse Rides

Beach horse rides can be arranged at the White Pearl Resort, not far from Blue Waves. This is quite a unique and serene experience, being able to ride in the shore break at sunrise or sunset on the breathtaking beaches.

- Special Elephant Reserve

The Maputo Special Elephant Reserve is a 30-minute drive from Blue Waves, perfect for a day trip into a game reserve where you can see wildlife such as zebra, giraffe, elephants, impala, wildebeest etc. Please note that you do need a 4x4 to drive through the reserve.

PAYMENT TERMS

- 50% deposit payable on booking with the balance due 30 days before arrival.
- R5,000 breakage deposit required, which is refundable within 5 days of departure.
- Please note that we only rent out the whole villa and not individual rooms.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Blue Waves Limitada reserves the right to charge the following cancellation charges:

- Less than 14 days prior to arrival: 100% of total cost of the reservation
- 15 to 29 days prior to arrival: 75% of total cost of the reservation
- 30 days or more prior to arrival: 50% of total cost of the reservation
- In the event of a no-show, the total cost of the reservation will be charged for.

DIRECTIONS FROM KOSI BAY BORDER POST

Option 1 – Tar/Sand Road (45 minutes / 35km)

- Follow the tar road to Zitundo for 16kms.
- Turn right at the Zitundo/ White Pearl Signboard.
- Travel along this road for approximately 11kms where it turns into soft sand and turn right (left takes you to the White Pearl Resort).
- Follow along this soft sand road until you see the Aloha entrance on your left.
- Turn into the entrance and follow the signboards to Aloha Number 27.

Option 2 – Beach Sand Road from Ponta do Ouro (1 hour) / 30km)

- Follow the tar road until you see the signboard for Ponta do Ouro. Turn right here and continue straight until you reach Love Café on your right hand side.
- Take the road to the left and engage 4×4. You will carry on along this sand road all the way to Ponta Mamoli, passing through Ponta Malongane.
- Please follow the signs for Aloha Estate (to the right) and you should be led straight to the Aloha Entrance.
- Turn into the entrance and follow the signs to Aloha Number 27.

GETTING TO BLUE WAVES

DIRECTIONS FROM RESSANO GARCIA / KOMATIPOORT BORDER

- Follow the main road for approximately 81kms towards Maputo.
- Turn left at Matola, continuing to follow the Maputo signboards.
- Continue on for 13km, following the signboards for Ponta do Ouro that will lead you across the new Maputo-Katembe Bridge.
- Stay on this road for approximately 100km, passing through the Special Elephant Reserve.
- Turn left at the Zitundo / White Pearl Signboard.
- Travel along this road for approximately 11kms where it turns into soft sand and turn right (left takes you to the White Pearl Resort).
- Follow along this soft sand road until you see the Aloha entrance on your left.
- Turn into the entrance and follow the signboards to Aloha Number 27.

Please note that there are tolls along all of the above routes which require payment in cash. MZN, ZAR and USD are accepted as payment methods.

We recommend that you download an offline map of the area from Google Maps prior to departure.

You can navigate to Aloha Beach Estate using Google Maps.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS & BORDER REQUIREMENTS

- A valid passport is required for entry into Mozambique (ensure that it is still valid for at least 6 months after date of entry and there are two blank pages in it).
- Unabridged birth certificates need to be presented at the border when travelling with minors (children under 18 years of age) as well as an affidavit if both biological parents are not present.
- Please ensure that you have your vehicle papers or police clearance papers and let us know if you require any further information regarding customs and excise allowances.
- You will need the original or certified copy of your vehicle registration papers, if the vehicle is not in your name then a letter from the owner of the vehicle, a letter from your Insurance Company stating that the vehicle is insured out of SA, a temporary drivers licence as well as 3rd Party Insurance which can be purchased at the border.
- Vehicle Entry into Mozambique costs MZN 750 / ZAR 200 and this must be paid in cash.
- A third party insurance is compulsory before your vehicle can enter Mozambique – whilst this can be done at the border, we recommend that you obtain it online prior to arrival (www.hollsure.co.za).
- SADC residents do not need a visa to enter Mozambique. A visa fee of USD 50 per person is payable for entry of non-SADC residents.

RESOURCES

BORDER TIMES

Kosi Bay Border: opens 8am – closes 5pm daily.

Komatipoort Border: open 24 hours

MALARIA

- Ponta Mamoli is officially listed as being a malaria area, although cases are rare, especially with the sea breeze.
- Guests should consult their doctor for any advice and about appropriate malaria prophylaxes.
- Please use preventative techniques even in combination with malaria prophylaxes, such as mosquito repellent sprays at night and wear long pants.

MOBILE NETWORK

- Mozambique Vodacom is found throughout most of the area and there is full 3G coverage at Blue Waves.
- We recommend that you purchase a Vodacom sim card in Ponta Malongane or Ponta do Ouro should you need mobile communications.
- There is complimentary WiFi at the Villa.

CURRENCY

- The local currency is Meticaís, but South African Rands are also welcomed.
- South African Rands are accepted as a payment currency at all shops, filling stations, restaurants etc and the rate is generally accepted as ZAR1 = MZN4
- The BCI bank (local Mozambican bank) has an ATM that is situated in the village in Ponta do Ouro. The daily withdrawal limit for cash at the ATM is R2000 per day and the ATM only gives the Mozambique currency.
- Not all places have card facilities – please ensure you take enough cash with you into Mozambique.
